She also worked on a large-scale policy evaluation study of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), monitoring implementation fidelity of Multi-Tiered Systems of Support for Behavior in two school districts. Rochi's work at AIR allowed her to gain a deeper understanding of the challenges associated with implementing complex systems across multiple contexts. In addition to her work at AIR, Rochi developed and maintains the official company website for PASS Accounting Solutions, a payroll management firm based in Colombo.

Her work experience in the development and education sectors let her to apply to the Johns Hopkins SAIS M.A. Program where she will be concentrating in International Development. Upon graduation she intends to work in the impact investment sector. Rochi's long term goal is to return to Sri Lanka to start an Impact Investment firm to fund social enterprises and and grow minority and women owned businesses around the island.
